2001 FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

The Center for Children of Incarcerated Parents offers fellowships to incarcerated parents. Fellowships support advanced education, research and advocacy work on issues related to parental incarceration. Up to four CCIP Fellows are selected during each application period; fellowships are awarded for from 12 to 24 months and include a stipend of up to \$1500 in educational materials. CCIP Fellows are required to produce independently or collaborate with CCIP staff on at least one educational, literary or advocacy project during each 12 months of their fellowship.

To apply: Submit an application to the Center for Children of Incarcerated Parents by January 31, 2001. Applications should be no more than 5 pages in length and should include the attached application form.

Applications must be accompanied by two letters of support from unrelated persons familiar with the applicant's work in education, activism or advocacy on issues related to parental incarceration. Letters of support should be mailed directly to the address below.
